


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Franklin County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Franklin County residents.
- Annually, 6 Franklin County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Franklin County residents.
- Annually, an average of 32 Franklin County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 22 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 3 Other

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Franklin County residents.
- Annually, 400 Franklin County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 320 Occupants
 - 45 Unspecified Persons
 - 16 Motorcyclists
 - 14 Pedestrians
 - 5 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
