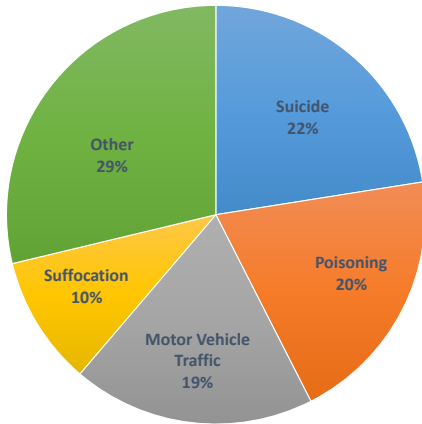
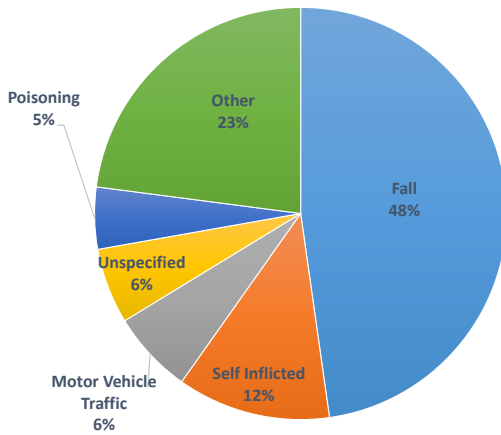

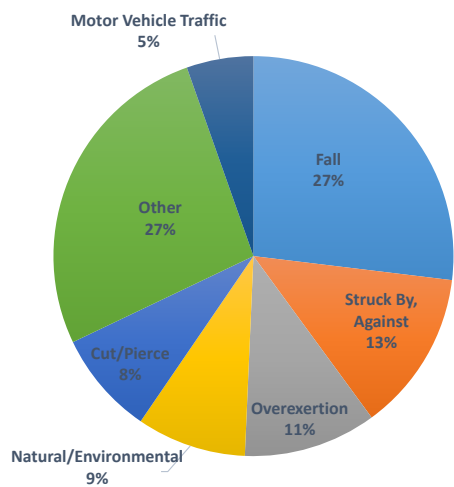
### Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Fulton County.
- Annually, 5 Fulton County Residents die due to traffic related injuries
  - 2 Occupants
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - \* Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Fulton County.
- Annually, 34 Fulton County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 23 Occupants
  - 8 Motorcyclists
  - 2 Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Bicyclists



### Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Fulton County.
- Annually, 406 Fulton County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 327 Occupants
  - 30 Unspecified Persons
  - 23 Motorcyclists
  - 15 Pedestrians
  - 4 Bicyclists
