


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Genesee County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Genesee County residents.
- Annually, 10 Genesee County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Unspecified
 - 3 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Genesee County residents.
- Annually, 42 Genesee County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 31 Occupants
 - 5 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Unspecified
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Genesee County residents.
- Annually, 1,477 Genesee County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 408 Occupants
 - 20 Motorcyclists
 - 20 Pedestrians
 - 17 Unspecified
 - 14 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
