


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Herkimer County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related death for Herkimer County residents.
- Annually, 6 Herkimer County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 3 Unspecified
  - 2 Occupants
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Herkimer County residents.
- Annually, 50 Herkimer County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 37 Occupants
  - 7 Motorcyclists
  - 3 Unspecified
  - 3 Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Herkimer County residents.
- Annually, 396 Herkimer County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 333 Occupants
  - 24 Unspecified
  - 20 Motorcyclists
  - 14 Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists
