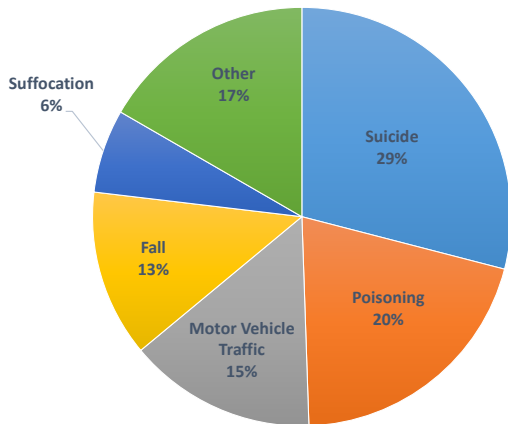
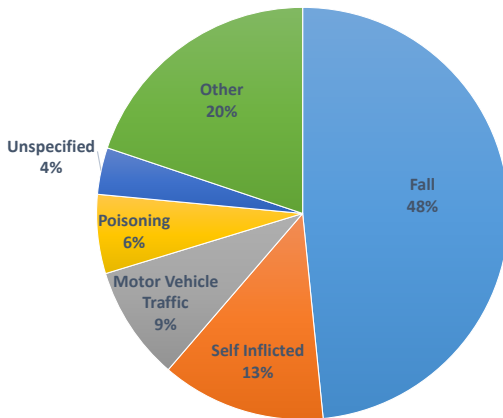


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Jefferson County Residents, 2012-2014



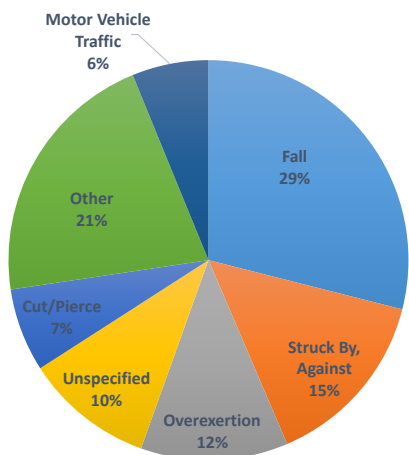
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Jefferson County.
- Annually, 9 Jefferson County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 6 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Jefferson County.
- Annually, 60 Jefferson County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 45 Occupants
 - 10 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Jefferson County.
- Annually, 811 Jefferson County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 667 Occupants
 - 52 Unspecified Persons
 - 48 Motorcyclists
 - 31 Pedestrians
 - 11 Bicyclists
