


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Jefferson County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Jefferson County residents.
- Annually, 13 Jefferson County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Occupants
 - 4 Unspecified
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Pedal Cyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Jefferson County residents.
- Annually, 68 Jefferson County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 50 Occupants
 - 9 Motorcyclists
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Jefferson County residents.
- Annually, 637 Jefferson County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 559 Occupants
 - 30 Motorcyclists
 - 24 Pedestrians
 - 18 Unspecified
 - 5 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other
