


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Kings County Residents, 2012-2014





Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Kings County.
- •Annually, 1,325 Kings County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 576 Pedestrians
 - 408 Occupants
 - 141 Motorcyclists
 - 131 Bicyclists
 - 60 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Kings County.
- Annually, 15,533 Kings County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 10,175 Occupants
 - 2,725 Pedestrians
 - 1,006 Unspecified Persons
 - 1,000 Onspecified
 - 970 Bicyclists
 - 485 Motorcyclists
