


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Kings County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Kings County residents.
- Annually, 129 Kings County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 54 Pedestrians
 - 45 Unspecified
 - 13 Motorcyclists
 - 12 Occupants
 - 5 Pedal Cyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Kings County residents.
- Annually, 1,655 Kings County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 743 Pedestrians
 - 568 Occupants
 - 142 Motorcyclists
 - 135 Pedal Cyclists
 - 64 Unspecified
 - 4 Other

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Kings County residents.
- Annually, 15,028 Kings County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 10,513 Occupants
 - 2,457 Pedestrians
 - 1,151 Unspecified
 - 621 Pedal Cyclists
 - 260 Motorcyclists
 - 25 Other
