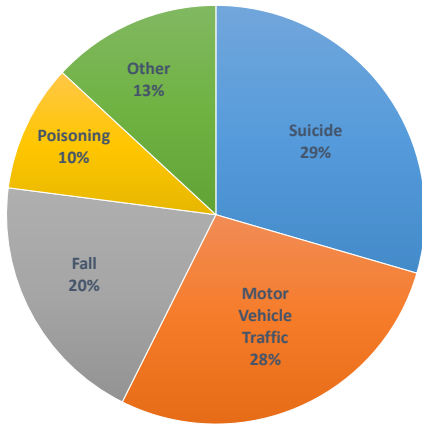
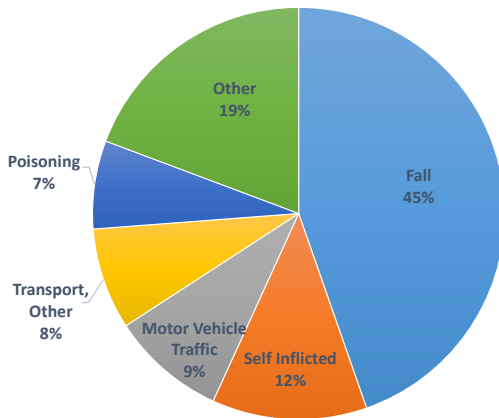


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Lewis County Residents, 2012-2014



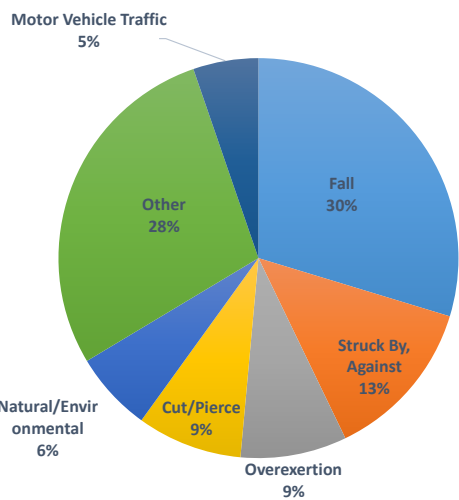
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Lewis County.
- Annually, 6 Lewis County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2 Occupants
 - 2 Unspecified Persons
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Lewis County.
- Annually, 14 Lewis County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 12 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - 0 Pedestrians
 - 0 Unspecified Persons
 - 0 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Lewis County.
- Annually, 128 Lewis County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 107 Occupants
 - 9 Unspecified Persons
 - 8 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists
