


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Livingston County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Livingston County residents.
- Annually, 8 Livingston County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 6 Unspecified
  - \* Occupants
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Livingston County residents.
- Annually, 53 Livingston County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 42 Occupants
  - 6 Motorcyclists
  - 2 Unspecified
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Livingston County residents.
- Annually, 422 Livingston County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 366 Occupants
  - 21 Motorcyclists
  - 17 Unspecified
  - 11 Pedal Cyclists
  - 7 Pedestrians
