


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Madison County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Madison County residents.
- Annually, 9 Madison County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 6 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Unspecified
 - * Pedestrian

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Madison County residents.
- Annually, 58 Madison County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 44 Occupants
 - 9 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - * Pedal Cyclists
 - * Unspecified

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Madison County residents.
- Annually, 458 Madison County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 414 Occupants
 - 17 Motorcyclists
 - 13 Unspecified
 - 10 Pedestrians
 - 5 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
