


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Monroe County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related death for Monroe County residents.
- Annually, 58 Monroe County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 33 Unspecified
  - 11 Occupants
  - 7 Motorcyclists
  - 5 Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Monroe County residents.
- Annually, 472 Monroe County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 304 Occupants
  - 63 Pedestrians
  - 62 Motorcyclists
  - 24 Pedal Cyclists
  - 19 Unspecified

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Monroe County residents.
- Annually, 5,546 Monroe County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 4,533 Occupants
  - 339 Unspecified
  - 305 Pedestrians
  - 194 Motorcyclists
  - 173 Pedal Cyclists
  - 2 Other
