


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Montgomery County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Montgomery County residents.
- Annually, 6 Montgomery County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 4 Unspecified
 - 2 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Montgomery County residents.
- Annually, 47 Montgomery County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 33 Occupants
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Unspecified
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Montgomery County residents.
- Annually, 484 Montgomery County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 403 Occupants
 - 41 Unspecified
 - 22 Pedestrians
 - 14 Motorcyclists
 - 5 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
