



Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits New York County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in New York County.
- Annually, 40 New York County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 26 Pedestrians
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in New York County.
- Annually, 640 New York County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 324 Pedestrians
 - 156 Occupants
 - 68 Bicyclists
 - 61 Motorcyclists
 - 22 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in New York County.
- Annually, 4,830 New York County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2,387 Occupants
 - 1,173 Pedestrians
 - 594 Unspecified Persons
 - 227 Motorcyclists
 - 403 Bicyclists
