


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### New York County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related death for New York County residents.
- Annually, 61 New York County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 33 Pedestrians
  - 15 Unspecified
  - 5 Motorcyclists
  - 5 Occupants
  - 3 Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for New York County residents.
- Annually, 752 New York County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 387 Pedestrians
  - 203 Occupants
  - 67 Pedal Cyclists
  - 59 Motorcyclists
  - 34 Unspecified
  - \* Other

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for New York County residents.
- Annually, 5,222 New York County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 3,131 Occupants
  - 1,277 Pedestrians
  - 334 Unspecified
  - 282 Pedal Cyclists
  - 189 Motorcyclists
  - 9 Other
