

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Niagara County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Niagara County.
- Annually, 21 Niagara County Residents die due to traffic related injuries
 - 8 Unspecified Persons
 - 6 Occupants
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - 2 Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Niagara County.
- Annually, 125 Niagara County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 73 Occupants
 - 25 Motorcyclists
 - 16 Pedestrians
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 5 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Niagara County.
- Annually, 1,784 Niagara County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,515 Occupants
 - 89 Pedestrians
 - 79 Unspecified Persons
 - 58 Motorcyclists
 - 37 Bicyclists
