


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Niagara County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Niagara County residents.
- Annually, 20 Niagara County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 10 Unspecified
 - 5 Occupants
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 2 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedal Cyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Niagara County residents.
- Annually, 185 Niagara County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 133 Occupants
 - 25 Motorcyclists
 - 15 Pedestrians
 - 6 Pedal Cyclists
 - 6 Unspecified

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Niagara County residents.
- Annually, 2,128 Niagara County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,820 Occupants
 - 93 Pedestrians
 - 93 Unspecified
 - 80 Motorcyclists
 - 40 Pedal Cyclists
 - 2 Other
