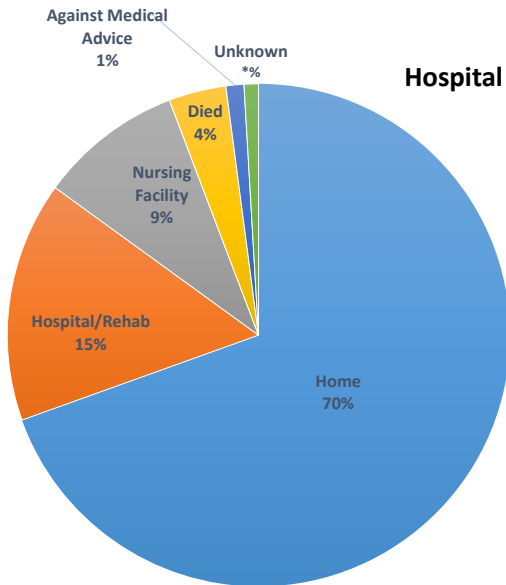


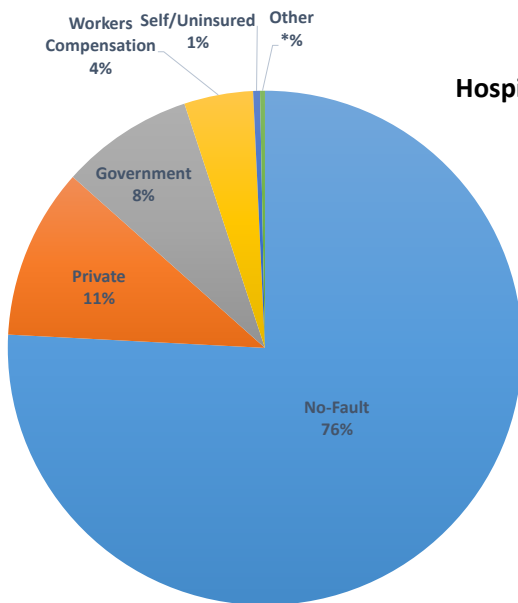
**Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges
Oneida County Residents, 2012-2014**



Hospital Discharge Disposition

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 144 hospitalizations

- 100 Were discharged to their home
- 22 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 13 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 5 Died
- * Left against medical advice



Hospitalization Charges

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$7.1 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$5.4 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$762.2 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$592.3 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$307.5 Thousand charged to workers compensation
- \$30.4 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
