


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Oneida County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Oneida County residents.
- Annually, 20 Oneida County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7 Not Specified
 - 6 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - * Pedal Cyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Oneida County residents.
- Annually, 179 Oneida County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 122 Occupants
 - 25 Motorcyclists
 - 17 Pedestrians
 - 9 Unspecified
 - 6 Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Oneida County residents.
- Annually, 1,881 Oneida County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 1,538 Occupants
 - 139 Unspecified
 - 84 Pedestrians
 - 75 Motorcyclist
 - 45 Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
