

## Leading Causes of All Injury

# Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits Ontario County Residents, 2012-2014




#### **Deaths**

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Ontario County.
- Annually, 11 Ontario County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 5 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Occupants
  - 2 Pedestrians
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - 0 Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Ontario County.
- •Annually, 59 Ontario County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 40 Occupants
  - 11 Motorcyclists
  - 4 Pedestrians
  - 3 Unspecified Persons
  - \* Bicyclists



## **Emergency Department (ED)**<sup>†</sup> Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Ontario County.
- Annually, 656 Ontario County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 551 Occupants
  - 23 Pedestrians
  - 31 Unspecified Persons
  - 41 Motorcyclists
  - 7 Bicyclists
