

Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department† (ED) Visits Orange County, New York Residents, 2005-2007




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Orange County residents.
- Annually, 41 Orange County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - o 22 Occupants
 - 8 Unspecified Persons
 - o 5 Pedestrians
 - o 5 Motorcyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Orange County residents.
- Annually, 341 Orange County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - o 230 Occupants
 - o 45 Motorcyclists
 - o 30 Unspecified Persons
 - 26 Pedestrians
 - 10 Pedal Cyclists



ED† Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Orange County residents.
- Annually, 4,090 Orange County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - o 3,543 occupants
 - o 235 unspecified persons
 - o 171 pedestrians
 - o 108 motorcyclists
 - o 33 pedal cyclists
