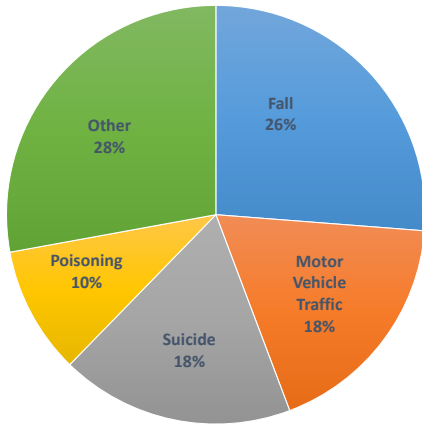
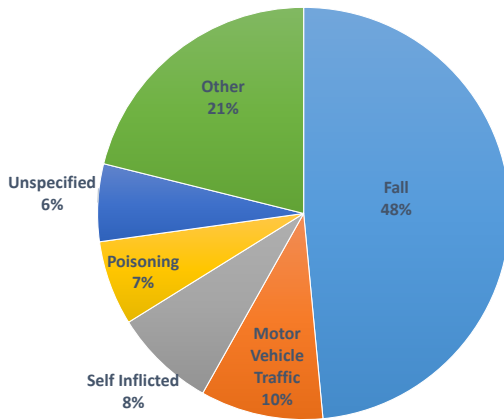


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Orleans County Residents, 2012-2014



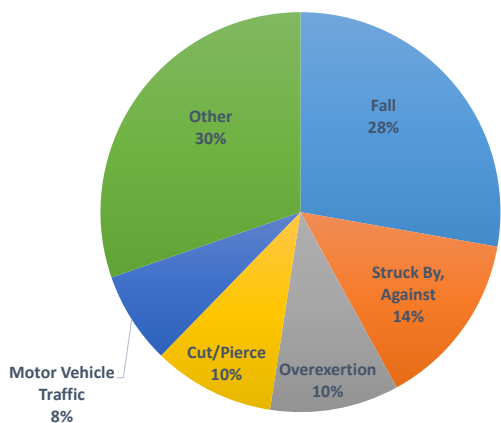
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Orleans County.
- Annually, 4 Orleans County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Orleans County.
- Annually, 33 Orleans County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 26 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - 5 Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Orleans County.
- Annually, 273 Orleans County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 242 Occupants
 - 12 Motorcyclists
 - 10 Unspecified Persons
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
