


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Orleans County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Orleans County residents.
- Annually, an average of 5 Orleans County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 4 Unspecified
  - \* Occupants
  - \* Motorcyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Orleans County residents.
- Annually, an average of 39 Orleans County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 28 Occupants
  - 4 Motorcyclists
  - 3 Pedestrians
  - 3 Unspecified
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Orleans County residents.
- Annually, an average 315 Orleans County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 281 Occupants
  - 11 Pedestrians
  - 11 Motorcyclists
  - 10 Unspecified
  - 2 Pedal Cyclists
