

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Oswego County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause of injury related death in Oswego County.
- Annually, 19 Oswego County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 14 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Oswego County.
- •Annually, 71 Oswego County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 50 Occupants
 - 10 Motorcyclists
 - 6 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Oswego County.
- Annually, 611 Oswego County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 483 Occupants
 - 59 Unspecified Persons
 - 32 Pedestrians
 - 27 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Bicyclists
