


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Oswego County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Oswego County residents.
- Annually, an average of 18 Oswego County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 10 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Unspecified
 - 2 Pedestrians

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Oswego County residents.
- Annually, an average 117 Oswego County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 84 Occupants
 - 17 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Pedestrians
 - 4 Unspecified
 - 3 Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Oswego County residents.
- Annually, an average 957 Oswego County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 789 Occupants
 - 66 Unspecified
 - 48 Motorcyclists
 - 40 Pedestrians
 - 14 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other
