


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Otsego County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Otsego County residents.
- Annually, an average of eight Otsego County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified
 - 3 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Pedal Cyclists
 - * Pedestrians

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Otsego County residents.
- Annually, an average of 53 Otsego County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 36 Occupants
 - 9 Motorcyclists
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 2 Unspecified
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Otsego County residents.
- Annually, an average of 452 Otsego County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 357 Occupants
 - 49 Unspecified
 - 24 Motorcyclists
 - 19 Pedestrians
 - 4 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other
