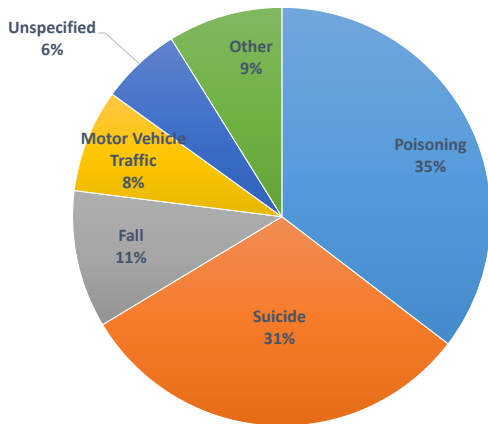
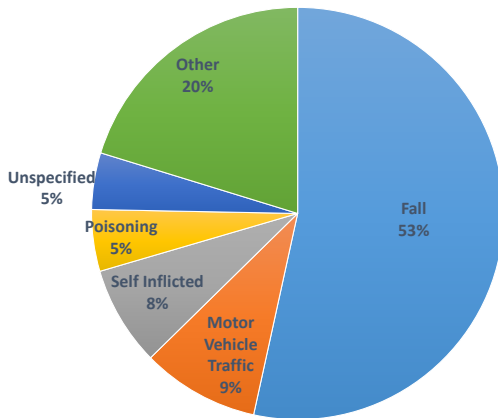

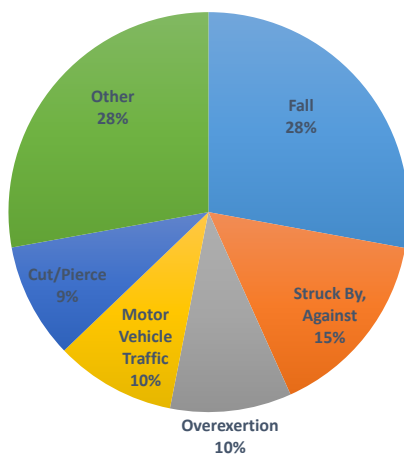
### Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Putnam County.
- Annually, 3 Putnam County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - \* Occupants
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - 0 Motorcyclists
  - 0 Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Putnam County.
- Annually, 55 Putnam County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 37 Occupants
  - 9 Motorcyclists
  - 4 Pedestrians
  - 3 Unspecified Persons
  - \* Bicyclists



### Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Putnam County.
- Annually, 757 Putnam County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 648 Occupants
  - 45 Unspecified Persons
  - 32 Motorcyclists
  - 22 Pedestrians
  - 2 Bicyclists
