


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Putnam County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Putnam County residents.
- Annually, an average of ten Putnam County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Unspecified
 - 3 Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Putnam County residents.
- Annually, an average 86 Putnam County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 62 Occupants
 - 11 Motorcyclists
 - 6 Pedestrians
 - 6 Unspecified
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Putnam County residents.
- Annually, an average 924 Putnam County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 825 Occupants
 - 41 Unspecified
 - 28 Motorcyclists
 - 25 Pedestrians
 - 4 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
