


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Queens County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related death for Queens County residents.
- Annually, 116 Queens County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 49 Pedestrians
  - 35 Unspecified Persons
  - 19 Occupants
  - 12 Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Queens County residents.
- Annually, 1,704 Queens County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 799 Occupants
  - 593 Pedestrians
  - 159 Motorcyclists
  - 80 Unspecified Persons
  - 72 Pedal Cyclists
  - \* Other Specified Persons

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Queens County residents.
- Annually, 14,695 Queens County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 11,490 Occupants
  - 1,795 Pedestrians
  - 789 Unspecified Persons
  - 312 Pedal Cyclists
  - 297 Motorcyclists
  - 12 Other Specified Persons

<sup>†</sup>The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
