


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Rensselaer County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Rensselaer County residents.
- Annually, 16 Rensselaer County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 6 Occupants Pedestrians
  - 6 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedestrians

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Rensselaer County residents.
- Annually, 101 Rensselaer County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 62 Occupants
  - 17 Motorcyclists
  - 11 Pedestrians
  - 8 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Rensselaer County residents.
- Annually, 1,331 Rensselaer County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 1,044 Occupants
  - 113 Unspecified Persons
  - 79 Motorcyclists
  - 73 Pedestrians
  - 23 Pedal Cyclists
