


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Richmond County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Richmond County residents.
- Annually, 25 Richmond County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 6 Unspecified Persons
 - 5 Occupants
 - 2 Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Richmond County residents.
- Annually, 578 Richmond County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 356 Occupants
 - 139 Pedestrians
 - 44 Motorcyclists
 - 22 Unspecified Persons
 - 17 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other Specified Persons

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Richmond County residents.
- Annually, 4,592 Richmond County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3,988 Occupants
 - 322 Pedestrians
 - 177 Unspecified Persons
 - 69 Motorcyclists
 - 28 Pedal Cyclists
 - 8 Other Specified Persons
