


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department† (ED) Visits


### Rockland County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Rockland County residents.
- Annually, 19 Rockland County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 8 Unspecified Persons
  - 4 Occupants
  - 3 Motorcyclists
  - 3 Pedestrians
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Rockland County residents.
- Annually, 215 Rockland County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 130 Occupants
  - 41 Pedestrians
  - 23 Motorcyclists
  - 16 Unspecified Persons
  - 6 Pedal Cyclists

#### ED† Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related outpatient ED† visits for Rockland County residents.
- Annually, 2,295 Rockland County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 2,014 Occupants
  - 132 Pedestrians
  - 68 Unspecified Persons
  - 58 Motorcyclists
  - 23 Pedal Cyclists
  - \* Other Specified Persons
