


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department† (ED) Visits


Saratoga County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Saratoga County residents.
- Annually, 20 Saratoga County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 8 Unspecified Persons
 - 8 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Saratoga County residents.
- Annually, 140 Saratoga County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 91 Occupants
 - 27 Motorcyclists
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 9 Unspecified Persons
 - * Pedal Cyclists

ED† Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED† visits for Saratoga County residents.
- Annually, 1,166 Saratoga County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 997 Occupants
 - 67 Motorcyclists
 - 52 Unspecified Persons
 - 34 Pedestrians
 - 16 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other Specified Persons
