


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Schenectady County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related death for Schenectady County residents.
- Annually, 9 Schenectady County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 4 Unspecified Persons
  - 2 Occupants
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Schenectady County residents.
- Annually, 115 Schenectady County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 69 Occupants
  - 16 Motorcyclists
  - 16 Pedestrians
  - 9 Unspecified Persons
  - 5 Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Schenectady County residents.
- Annually, 1,375 Schenectady County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 1,173 Occupants
  - 72 Pedestrians
  - 50 Motorcyclists
  - 41 Unspecified Persons
  - 39 Pedal Cyclists
  - \* Other Specified Persons
