


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Schoharie County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Schoharie County residents.
- Annually, 5 Schoharie County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Schoharie County residents.
- Annually, 26 Schoharie County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 17 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Pedestrians

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Schoharie County residents.
- Annually, 274 Schoharie County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 234 Occupants
 - 16 Unspecified Persons
 - 16 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Pedestrians
 - * Pedal Cyclists

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
