


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Schuyler County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related death for Schuyler County residents.
- During the three-year period, less than six Schuyler County Residents died due to traffic related injuries.
  - \* Occupants
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - \* Unspecified Persons

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Schuyler County residents.
- Annually, 18 Schuyler County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 12 Occupants
  - 4 Motorcyclists
  - \* Unspecified Persons

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Schuyler County residents.
- Annually, 166 Schuyler County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 140 Occupants
  - 12 Motorcyclists
  - 6 Pedestrians
  - 6 Unspecified Persons
  - \* Pedal Cyclists
  - \* Other
