

# Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits

## Seneca County Residents, 2012-2014




#### **Deaths**

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Seneca County.
- •Annually, 5 Seneca County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 3 Unspecified Persons
  - \* Occupants

  - \* Motorcyclists
  - 0 Bicyclists



#### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Seneca County.
- Annually, 18 Seneca County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 14 Occupants
  - 3 Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - 0 Bicyclists



### **Emergency Department (ED)**<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Seneca County.
- Annually, 219 Seneca County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 182 Occupants
  - 15 Motorcyclists
  - 14 Unspecified Persons
  - 5 Pedestrians
  - \* Bicyclists
