


# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department<sup>†</sup> (ED) Visits


### Seneca County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

#### Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Seneca County residents.
- Annually, an average of 6 Seneca County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 4 Occupants
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedestrians

#### Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Seneca County residents.
- Annually, 25 Seneca County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 17 Occupants
  - 4 Motorcyclists
  - \* Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Pedal Cyclists

#### ED<sup>†</sup> Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED<sup>†</sup> visits for Seneca County residents.
- Annually, 238 Seneca County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
  - 200 Occupants
  - 19 Unspecified Persons
  - 9 Motorcyclists
  - 6 Pedestrians
  - 3 Pedal Cyclists
  - \* Other
