


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department† (ED) Visits


St. Lawrence County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for St. Lawrence County residents.
- Annually, 15 St. Lawrence County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7 Unspecified Persons
 - 4 Occupants
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other Specified Persons

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for St. Lawrence County residents.
- Annually, 71 St. Lawrence County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 51 Occupants
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Unspecified Persons
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - * Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other Specified Persons

ED† Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED† visits for St. Lawrence County residents.
- Annually, 789 St. Lawrence County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 644 Occupants
 - 75 Unspecified Persons
 - 32 Motorcyclists
 - 26 Pedestrians
 - 9 Pedal Cyclists
 - 3 Other Specified Persons

† The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
