


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits


Steuben County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths




- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Steuben County residents.
- Annually, an average of 18 Steuben County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 14 Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Steuben County residents.
- Annually, 88 Steuben County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 62 Occupants
 - 15 Motorcyclists
 - 5 Pedestrians
 - 4 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Pedal Cyclists

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Steuben County residents.
- Annually, 769 Steuben County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 646 Occupants
 - 41 Motorcyclists
 - 39 Unspecified Persons
 - 29 Pedestrians
 - 14 Pedal Cyclists
 - * Other

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
