

Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Yates County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Yates County.
- •Annually, 2 Yates County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.

 - * Unspecified Persons

 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Yates County.
- Annually, 16 Yates County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 11 Occupants
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Yates County.
- Annually, 152 Yates County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 126 Occupants
 - 9 Unspecified Persons
 - 9 Motorcyclists
 - 4 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
