

## Leading Causes of All Injury

# Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits New York State Residents, 2012-2014




#### **Deaths**

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the fourth leading cause of injury related death in New York State.
- Annually, 1,098 New York State Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 292 Occupants
  - 312 Pedestrians
  - 316 Unspecified Persons
  - 141 Motorcyclists
  - 36 Bicyclists



#### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in New York State.
- Annually, 12,093 New York State Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 6,207 Occupants
  - 3,027 Pedestrians
  - 1,558 Motorcyclists
  - 637 Bicyclists
  - 561 Unspecified Persons



### **Emergency Department (ED)**<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in New York State.
- Annually, 136,913 New York State Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 106,612 Occupants
  - 12,506 Pedestrians
  - 8,455 Unspecified Persons
  - 4,458 Motorcyclists
  - 3,795 Bicyclists
