SPARCS Injury, Cause, and Place Code Set (Update & Remediation) The <u>SPARCS Injury, Cause, and Place Code Set</u> specifies whether a cause and/or place of injury is required on SPARCS data when an applicable injury code is reported. Information on this code set is available on the SPARCS website. SPARCS Injury Diagnosis Edits check the primary diagnosis codes, additional diagnosis codes, as well as the external cause of injury diagnosis codes for required cause and/or place of injury. Secondary Diagnosis Edit checks certain injury diagnosis codes for additional diagnosis code required. The SPARCS Injury Edit Remediation Project will focus on: Discharge years 2016 – 2023 ***UPDATE: Only 2018 – 2023 discharge years will be included in the remediation project.** Inpatient and Emergency Department claim types only Remediation efforts focus on data that was allowed into the system but that should have been stopped by N0003 and N0002 edits An initial email notification will be sent to SPARCS Coordinators for affected facilities. Claim detail files will be transferred to facilities via HCS. Facilities must resubmit files with appropriate external cause and/or place of injury codes.
