**Please Note:**

(1) Enrolled in EI - Children were counted if they were enrolled in EI at any time during the year, regardless of the length of time in the EIP.

(2) Age group is based on the child's age on 7/1/2017. Children born during the year are counted toward the age group "Birth - < 1 Year Old."

(3) Sum of percents may not equal 100% due to rounding.

(4) The sum of the counts by county does not equal the statewide or New York City totals because children move and are counted in each county in which they resided, but are only counted once in a given year in the totals.
